We are living our lives on a battlefield, and we have an enemy called Satan. He hates us and wants nothing less than our allegiance, which he secures through our disbelief in the truth of God or our disobedience to the will of God. A healthy spiritual life requires that we remain aware of this warfare. However, the Bible is clear: we are to fix our eyes on Jesus and stand firm against the lies and schemes of Satan. This resource helps us understand what our enemy is capable of and NOT capable of, so we don't ascribe any attribute or ability to him that actually belongs to God alone. *Ephesians 6:11; Hebrews 12:2*

## Satan's strategy to defeat us:

He tempts us to do the *exact opposite* of God's will by appealing to our desires, emotions, lusts, and fears.

He attacks our perception of God, which impacts our relationship to Him.

He destroys our relationships with other people by leading us to make selfish choices, to believe things about ourselves and others that are not true, and to disobey God's relational commands.

He offers us a trade:

The temporal (world) for the eternal (Kingdom of God)

Religious activities for true discipleship

Time for everything, but NO time to read the Word of God, pray, serve, or be in Christian community

We must operate from this reality: JESUS HAS ALREADY WON THE BATTLE BECAUSE HE HAS ALREADY DEFEATED SATAN! So, we fight on this battlefield with authority and from victory. Therefore, we ARE overcomers. Now we need to live like it! *Romans 8:37; Ephesians 1:21; Colossians 2:15; 1 John 3:8*
