Hiding God's Word in our hearts is an important Christian discipline. It is a pathway to renewing our minds and living in freedom. Memorizing Scripture also equips us to build others up with the Word of God instead of our own opinions. Below is a starter list of verses and passages to memorize that can be used individually or in a group. Memorizing the Apostle's Creed is also important because it summarizes the core beliefs *all* Christians have in common.
